Project Alpha

The IDEaL Education Foundation provides annual financial and volunteer support for Project Alpha, a collaborative program developed with the March of Dimes Birth Defects Foundation to provide young men, ages 12-15, with information, motivation, and the necessary skills surrounding issues of responsibility, relationships, teen pregnancy, and sexually transmitted diseases. Project Alpha is held in the fall of each year, and consists of an intensive series of workshops and informational sessions conducted by adult volunteer facilitators and medical professionals/experts.

Leadership Development Institute

The IDEaL Education Foundation annually sponsors high school students to participate in the Leadership Development Institute (LDI) program, and provides a direct mentoring relationship between each participating student and a member of the Foundation's Trustee Board. The Leadership Development Institute (LDI) is a weekend long retreat that equips high school students with vital leadership skills, including parliamentary procedures, conflict resolution, models of leadership, public speaking, community and civic engagement, and educational enhancement.

A Voteless People Is A Hopeless People

The IDEaL Education Foundation implements A Voteless People Is A Hopeless People as an annual voter education workshop targeting Chicago-area youth. Through school-based workshop activities, adult volunteers focus on the history of voting, voter registration, the voting process and the U.S. government, and political participation.

Go-To-High School, Go-To-College Mentoring Program

The "Go-to-High-School, Go-to-College" Mentoring Program, concentrates on the importance of completing secondary and collegiate education as a road to advancement. Statistics prove the value of this extra impetus in making the difference in the success of young African-American men, given that school completion is the single best predictor of future economic success. Through the Go-to-High-School, Go-to-College educational initiative, young men receive information through workshops, college access events/tours and learn strategies that facilitate success. Members of the Iota Delta Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. and other community partners provide youth participants with excellent role models/mentors to emulate. Our program is open to all Chicagoland male students in middle to high school.

Oratorical Contest

The IDEaL Education Foundation hosts an annual Oratorical Contest for Chicago-area junior high and high school students in an effort to promote the continued development of public speaking and writing skills among young men. The Contest is designed to expose youth to historical and contemporary oration, writing, and creative verbal and theatrical expression. Participating students compete against peers in the one-day contest, and the Foundation awards cash and other prizes for top student performers.

Boy Scouts of America

The IDEaL Education Foundation sponsors Cub Scouts Pack #350 and Boy Scouts Troop #350, both located in Dolton, Illinois, and provides over 1000 volunteer hours and financial support for related scouting activities.

Scholarship Program Overview

The IDeAL Education Foundation awards scholarships to deserving Chicago-area male high school and undergraduate college students at its annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship Luncheon. To be eligible, scholarship applicants must hold a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or greater (4.0 scale); be actively involved in church, community, and/or school-site activities; and, if in high school, plan to enroll at a four-year college/university.
